



Dear Friend,

*"The first case of AIDS has been diagnosed in Maine" read the 1985 editorial in Our Paper. All of us, it continued, are affected. All of us **will** be affected. All of us from Kittery to Fort Kent will find ourselves grappling with this painful and cruel reality...We, as a community, and as individuals, will never be the same."*

That was our wake-up call some twenty-five years ago and our community responded. A group of dedicated volunteers came together to battle what was then a mysterious and very fatal illness. Starting as a community-based hotline, growing into The AIDS Project and then eventually merging with Peabody House, Frannie Peabody Center has a rich history of serving people across the state of Maine.

In the six short years since I joined the agency, we have seen many changes – not only at the organizational level but also in the history of the HIV epidemic itself. Most notably, last year's closure and sale of Peabody House represented a significant chapter in the history of HIV in Maine. Yet, even that has been eclipsed by the dramatic shifts we see in the clients we serve. With our help, some of these clients successfully manage everything from medical protocols to their housing. Others we assist face daunting barriers created by such issues as mental health, substance abuse and societal stigmas that have still not gone away over two decades later.

We now serve over 100 more clients than we did in 2004 and that number continues to grow. Of our current 386 clients, our roster now includes more women and children, immigrants and refugees than ever before, and we continue to see rapid growth in our numbers of HIV positive men as well. Contrary to popular belief, for all these men, women and children, and those like them at risk – *from Kittery to Fort Kent* – HIV has **not** gone away.

Yet, we have witnessed this growth of our client base with no significant increase in state or federal funding. Instead, we stand today as a testament to the generosity and dedication of the volunteers, donors and selfless individuals who banded together 25 years ago. Like you, they each share a commitment embodied by our namesake Frannie Peabody and the founders of The AIDS Project and Peabody House and make Frannie Peabody Center what it is today.

This same type of support and generosity is critical to continuing our mission. Just last month, two of our clients succumbed to complications from HIV, a stark reminder to us all about how much further we have to go and how much our clients need you there to help. Your continuing commitment plays a vital role in easing the burden for all of our clients, and you have our most heartfelt appreciation.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Frannie Peabody Center is Maine's largest community-based HIV/AIDS service organization, providing prevention services for people at-risk and direct services for people living with HIV/AIDS. Frannie Peabody Center promotes awareness and risk-reduction through prevention education, outreach, and anonymous HIV testing services. Frannie Peabody Center also provides case management, support services, and housing assistance programs for people living with HIV/AIDS. In 2009, we continued to expand these services to better serve our clients and communities. We have chosen to focus our 2009 annual report on three areas of service: prevention, independent housing and case management.

PREVENTION

Frannie Peabody Center provides HIV prevention services from our storefront office on Oak Street in downtown Portland, as well as from Meadowbrook Plaza in York. We provide free, rapid, anonymous HIV testing to a wide array of people at risk, including: men who have sex with men, people who use drugs and/or alcohol, women with multiple or high risk partners, racial and ethnic minorities, people who have been incarcerated, people who have a sexually transmitted disease, and others at risk. In 2009, our prevention staff provided 800 hours of outreach to more than 15,000 high-risk individuals in Cumberland and York counties.

- In 2009, we tested 612 people for HIV
- About 85% of all individuals tested had high risk behaviors for HIV transmission
- One year of treatment for HIV can cost between \$13,000 and \$35,000
- The U.S. Centers for Disease Control & Prevention has issued guidance that HIV antibody testing should be a routine part of everyone's health care.

HOUSING

As part of its mission, Frannie Peabody Center is committed to meeting the housing needs of people living with HIV/AIDS in Maine. Frannie Peabody Center's statewide housing assistance program provides rental subsidies and short-term housing and utility assistance to low-income people living with HIV/AIDS. Frannie Peabody Center partners with Shalom House, the City of Portland and Maine's Ryan White-funded medical and case-management agencies, ensuring access to housing services for people living with HIV/AIDS throughout Maine. Stable, affordable housing is a fundamental necessity for people with HIV/AIDS to receive life-saving medical and support services and decrease the likelihood of exposing others to HIV infection.

According to The National AIDS Housing Coalition, there is "strong empirical support for a shift in the HIV risk paradigm, away from a focus on individual behaviors only, to a focus on risky contexts such as homelessness and unstable housing as structural factors that must be addressed in order to effectively prevent and treat HIV."

- 281 people living with HIV/AIDS statewide accessed some form of FPC's HOPWA Housing support in 2009
- 100 clients accessed FPC housing assistance while obtaining case management in Central or Northern Maine at other AIDS Service Organizations

- Frannie Peabody Center clients who do not have rental subsidies will spend nearly all of their income on rent
- A new Life Skills Case Manager position focuses on specific goals with clients in order to help clients maintain stable housing and improve their health and wellbeing
- 27 households reporting unstable housing situations at the beginning of 2009 were in stable housing situations by the end of the year
- 6 households facing eviction were able to maintain housing
- 70 clients experienced loss of a job or reduction in hours and income through 2009.
- 5 households burdened by increased heating costs were able to maintain their utilities
- Overall, 95% of Housing program clients were able to obtain or maintain stable, permanent housing as a result of assistance

CASE MANAGEMENT

Frannie Peabody Center provides professional, client-centered, primary case management services to people living with HIV/AIDS in Cumberland and York counties. Our trained case managers provide referrals, transportation, coordination of care, support and advocacy helping clients meet their medical, psychological, legal and physical needs. In 2009, FPC has started a new nutrition initiative. The case management program has continued successful supportive service projects like the women's group, knitting group and client newsletter.

- Based on emerging nutrition needs, we now fund and facilitate access to a monthly food program
In 2009, our case managers spent more than 6,300 hours in direct contact with clients, an increase of 40% from 2008
- Case managers assess clients at intake and annually thereafter to determine client needs
- Each quarter, clients establish a care plan with their case managers, based on needs identified in the assessment
- Case managers help clients reach their quarterly goals through referrals, advocacy, support, and coordination of care
- 98% of clients all clients were enrolled in an insurance coverage program by the end of 2009

PARTNER PROFILES

Board Member John Hatcher

Around Frannie Peabody Center, realtor John Hatcher is even more than the “Housesold Name” of Keller Williams Realty by which most of Portland and lots of Mainers know him. He’s also a diligent and hard-working member of FPC’s Board of Directors where he has served for seven years.

So whether it’s at the beach or in the FPC boardroom, John brings a special knowledge of FPC history and legacy to all of our events.

Community Partner: The Donato J. Tramuto Foundation

Some of the greatest generosity is often born of the most difficult circumstances. FPC supporter and community partner The Donato J. Tramuto Foundation exemplifies such benevolence. In 2001, Donato Tramuto was scheduled to board United Flight 175 on his weekly commute between Maine and California, along with two friends and their 3-year-old son who happened to be visiting him in Maine. But rescheduling a dental appointment had Donato taking an earlier flight on Monday instead of the next morning -- Tuesday, September 11th. Unfortunately, his friends boarded Flight 175 and lost their lives along with countless others that terrible September morning.

Shaken and moved by the tragic loss of his friends and so many others, the Tramuto Foundation was established. Now nearly ten years old, the Tramuto Foundation not only provides incredible opportunities to young people with special challenges but also assists community-based organizations like FPC that are helping individuals and communities overcome a wide variety of adversity. Recognizing the unique and difficult circumstances that people living with HIV/AIDS in Maine face daily, the Tramuto Foundation is one of a number of foundations for which we are the extremely grateful recipient of their kindness, generosity and support.

Donato himself knows adversity well, having struggled and overcome the many obstacles that accompanied the severe hearing loss he suffered as a young child. But his personal struggles and history only strengthen his resolve to help as many young people and organizations as possible to achieve the excellence he himself embodies in his professional life and on the many non-profit boards for which he serves. It's an excellence the people of Ogunquit, Maine know quite well too as Donato serves as elected official in the town FPC calls its second home, and where along with his partner Jeff Porter, owns and operates the delectable Café Prego and Five-0 Restaurants.

We at FPC are committed to that same excellence in striving to serve the greater community and honored to partner with the Donato Tramuto Foundation to help ease the burden of people living with HIV/AIDS in Maine.

Staff Profile: Director of Programs Jennifer Putnam

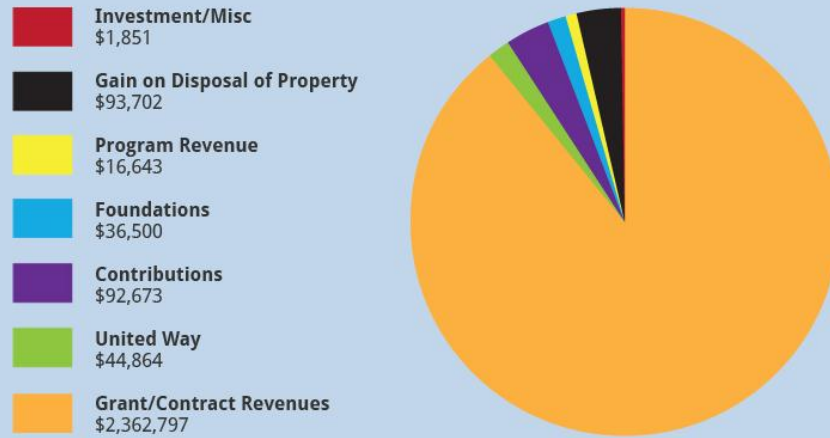

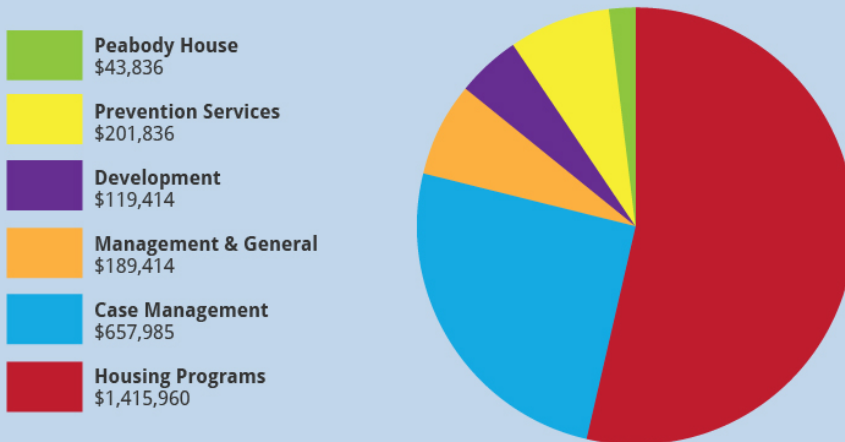
